Area XI presented a state qualifier proposal for consideration for 2021 that would allow 4 teams per area & have 1 qualifier from each area be considered a Wildcard qualifier. The wildcard would be considered by the highest score advancing to state, no matter what area they compete with. The number of the wildcard qualifiers would then be made by the number of areas competing the same day & place. If a provider had only 1 area competing, then top 5 would qualify. If 15% came into play & 8 qualified, then 7 would qualify & then 1 team from that area would be the wildcard qualifier.

Ryan Saucier, STSU, recommended a welding CDE contest which would have 4 members completing an hour exam & 3 different skill sets.

Dr Rayfield reported that the Ag Comm. superintendent would like to stretch contest to 2 days to allow for scoring/reviewing. Friday afternoon would be the particum portion.

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
